LATE FEE/REFUND POLICY

TUITION PAYMENT IN FULL DUE BY JULY 1, 2011. If tuition is not received in full or payment arrangements made within the 15-day grace period, the student will be dropped from enrollment lists, and a \$100.00 late fee per child will be assessed to your account. In addition, 1.5% interest will be added monthly to unpaid balances effective August 1, 2011. No admission if previous years account has not been paid in full. There is no late fee for new families enrolling after July 1. REFUND POLICY: Due to fixed costs, no refund of tuition can be made after January 31, 2012. If a student is newly enrolled second semester, no refund can be given after March 31, 2012. Refunds will be calculated based on student's attendance per academic quarter.
