

# Transportation Information

## Please read carefully

## Transportation Options:

Traverse City Area Public Schools (TCAPS) provides numerous transportation options for all GTACS students that live in the Grand Traverse area. The options are listed below:

- You may have your student take the bus to and from your home if you live in the Traverse City school district;
- Or, in the morning, you may drop your student at the GTACS connection shuttle at West Middle School (west side families) or East Middle School (east side families) to meet the bus going directly to their school;
- In the afternoon, you may pick your student up at the GTACS connection shuttle at West Senior High (west side families) or Central High School (east side families) and take them home. (**Please note a new policy:** Students will not be released from the bus until public school dismissal. The only way a student can be released is to have a parent come to the bus and ask for them to be released.)

You may drive, carpool, or a combination of the above;

## St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Middle School (SEAS)

You **MUST** sign up for this shuttle each year. No forms will be rolled over from a previous year. SEAS students, who qualify under the TCAPS guidelines, are provided shuttles to and from Immaculate Conception Elementary School or to and from St. Francis High School.

**The priority for use of this shuttle is on a first come, first available basis.**

**IC Shuttle \*Schedule:** Two shuttles depart at 7:25 a.m. from Immaculate Conception Elementary School parking lot and transport 6th, 7th & 8th graders to SEAS; Shuttles return to same location at end of day at approximately 3:00 p.m.

**SF Shuttle \*Schedule:** Two shuttles depart at 7:25 a.m. from in front of St. Francis High School gym and transports 6th, 7th & 8th graders to SEAS; Shuttle returns to 10th Street near Holy Angels Playground at end of day at approximately 3:00 p.m.

*\*Please note there are some days when TCAPS transportation is not available. See school calendar for specific dates and information.*

Transportation Enrollment Forms must be filled out to use any TCAPS transportation and will only be accepted with a completed Re-Enrollment Packet (in-system families) or Enrollment Packet (new families). Any missing information or signatures on any re-enrollment or registration papers will result in the information being put on hold until everything is complete. Please be sure to check your information before submitting.

**The list of students who will be given shuttle passes and those on the waiting list will be provided to the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Middle School Office as soon as lists are compiled. Shuttle passes will be distributed the first week of school to students who qualify. Only students who have a pass will be allowed to ride the specific shuttle they were assigned. No special passes will be issued for extracurricular or social reasons.**
