NMC Presidential Scholarship	8-Apr-10	Any high school senior who plans to enroll at NMC in the fall and currently has a 3.75 GPA or higher can apply for this Presidential Scholarship. The Presidential Scholarship, \$2,000, is renewable for the second year. A letter of recommendation must be sent from the school principal recommending the senior for this award.
AAA Michigan School Safety Patrol Scholarship	15-Apr-10	Two scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who served as AAA School Safety Patrol Members in Michigan. Students must show documented proof of AAA Michigan Safety Patrol participation, good academic standing and a strong record of participation in community and extra-curricular activities. Lambert Scholarship (St. Francis Parish)	16-Apr-10	The St. Francis Parish Lambert Scholarship has been established to recognize a graduating senior within the parish who best exemplifies a student living his/her Catholic faith.
