Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and enroll at NMC as a science major. Recipients are required to take at least one science course per semester. <p>Michigan Oil and Gas Producers Education Foundation</p>	<p>1-Apr-10</p>	<p>Qualified applicants must have been accepted for enrollment at a Michigan university or community college, have a minimum 3.0 GPA computed on a 4.0 scale and demonstrate financial need. Qualified applicants must be pursuing a degree in a field of study which will allow them to obtain fulltime employment in the crude oil and natural gas industry.</p>
