Textbook Buyback (Revised)

There are 3 options this year for buyback of your textbooks through ESCO Books.

1. An in-school buyback will take place on Thursday, June 10, 2009 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm in the St. Francis gym. Your student will simply fill out a form, put the books in a bag (provided) and turn them in to the workers. You do not pay the shipping costs with this option.
2. **Pre-paid shipping labels and buyback forms are now available in the high school office for you to pick up.** Take a buyback form and shipping label then return the books on your own with your own box. You do not pay the shipping costs with this option.
3. You can go online to www.sfhsbooks.com, log in and click on “Sell your Books”. You can enter your books to return, print a form and a shipping label and ship them out in your own box at your convenience. However, with this option the shipping charges will be deducted from your return credit.

With each of these methods you will receive a credit towards your 2010-2011 books or can request a refund check. (Parents: please be sure to let your student know which option you prefer or feel free to attend the buyback with your student!) If you have friends or relatives in grades behind your student you may also sell your books directly to them or keep them for siblings who are a year or two behind your current high schooler. A complete list of books that will be needed for next year’s classes will be available soon as well as estimated buyback prices.

Seniors can turn in their parking pass for a refund to the office or on Thursday June 10th at the book return in the gym.
